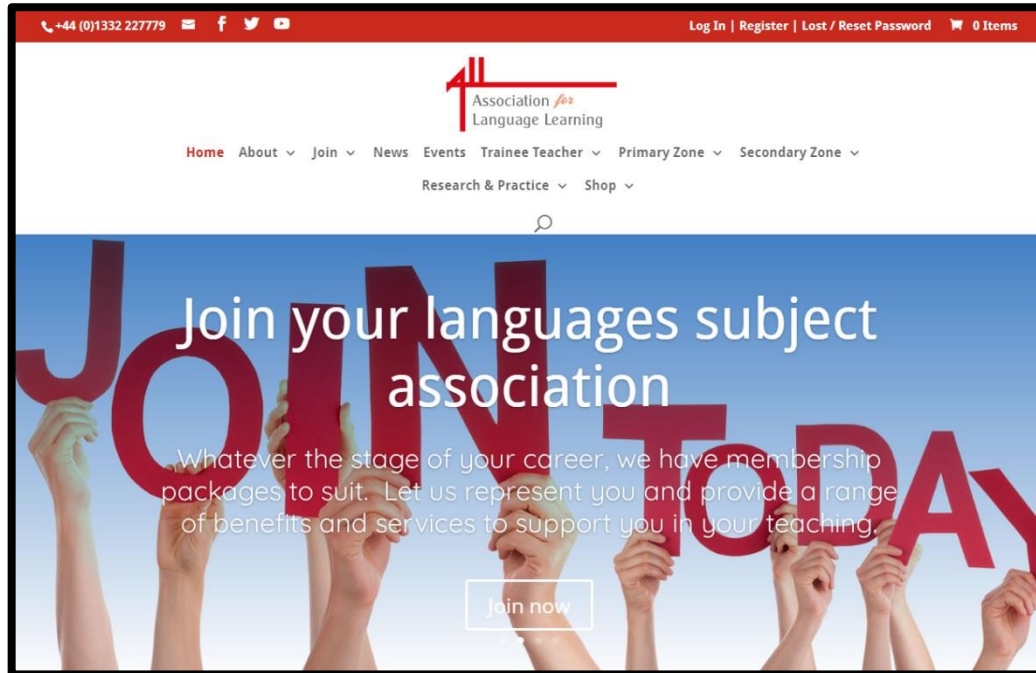

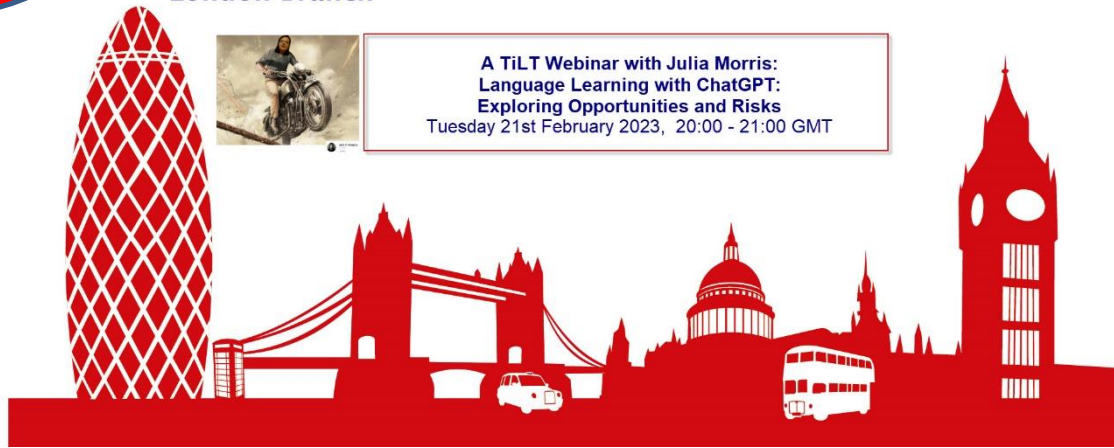

BACKGROUND

ALL London TILT (Technology in Language Teaching) webinars

In order to support language teachers faced with 'lockdown' ALL London (with its Zoom account and website) has teamed up with Joe Dale (Chief Talent Scout and tech networker extraordinaire) to host a wide variety of practising teachers and lecturers from across the world who share their experience of using technology to connect with students during periods when they cannot meet face-to-face. Sessions cover a wide range of aspects to consider for all sectors:

- common platforms for communication,
- designing a curriculum which can pivot between no tech / all tech and the spectrum of hybridity between, finding, creating and storing online resources and activities for all skills at all stages of the learning process (e.g. presentation, practice, production) which will motivate and interest learners working in isolation, all with their own individual needs and perspectives
- Tools and resources to assess learning formatively and summatively, providing learners with helpful feedback (rewards and indication about how to progress)

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This session focuses on the development of students' grasp of grammatical concepts while exercising their ability to negotiate, adjust, and apply new structures in the target language. The presentation will model methodology and resources that result in efficient and successful acquisition of language, retention, and communication in the target language. Participants will learn to guide their students to discover, understand, and use grammatical structures as they naturally occur in language - both thematically and contextually - via compelling and relevant authentic resources. This ACTFL core practice streamlines student exposure to language constructs, initiating implicit understanding prior to engaging in explicit instruction. The exploratory and experiential approach to grammar learning precipitates a deeper understanding of how the language works, building a higher level of grammatical competence that ultimately leads to greater comprehensibility and proficiency.

Caroline Schlegel + Aubrey Swisher

Caroline is a master Spanish educator committed to students, professional development, and advocacy. She was recently named Washington County Public Schools 2021-2022 Teacher of the year and was also the 2019 Maryland World Language Teacher of the Year. Caroline understands that language and culture are the keys to making connections across complex ideas with cultural proficiency. She believes professional development is integral in sustaining quality programs and presents across the nation to build a community of practice to connect and lead teachers through collaboration. Caroline holds a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from Salisbury University, an Advanced Hispanic Studies Certificate from La Universidad de Malaga, and is a recipient of the Global Seal of Bilingualism.

Enthusiastic secondary-level Spanish teacher, world language department leader, and advisor of Spanish National Honor Society at Boonsboro High School in Maryland, Aubrey Swisher celebrates diversity as she equips her students with broadened perspectives, compassion, and global competence.
